Pilotage and Seamanship Voyages

Sail the open lake on these learning voyages: Ideal for sailors interested in developing the skills necessary for making extended passages under sail. Topics covered will include: passage planning, pilotage and navigation, safety underway, anchoring, overnight passage making, weather forecasting, intermediate seamanship, and craft of traditional sail.

Nature Photography Cruise with Kent Miller

This course is designed for beginning and intermediate amateur photographers. You will learn the basics of photography and shoot daily assignments. Topics will include wildlife/landscape photography, portraiture composition, light, camera controls, exposure, Photoshop, flash and more. Your work will be critiqued. A digital camera is required. A digital single lens reflex camera (DSLR) is highly recommended. *Kent Miller has 27 years experience as a photographer, photojournalist and photo editor. He currently teaches photojournalism at Central Michigan University. His work has been published in newspapers and magazines throughout the U.S. including The New York Times and Time Magazine. Miller has also published images in several books.*

The APPLEDORE V is owned and operated by BaySail, a private, non-profit organization based on the Great Lakes in Bay City, Michigan. BaySail's mission is: "To foster environmental stewardship of the Saginaw Bay watershed and the Great Lakes ecosystem and to provide personal development opportunities for learners of all ages through shipboard and land based educational experiences."

The APPLEDORE V is primarily used for weeklong overnight sail training and freshwater exploration voyages and participation in Tall Ships events. The ship is the fifth in a series of similar gaff rigged 2-masted schooners designed by Bud McIntosh and commissioned by Disney Photographer Herb Smith. Herb Smith's world cruising adventures aboard the Appledores are chronicled in two books: "Dreams of Natural Places", and "Sailing Three Oceans".
