**VOYAGE #1 – LAKE HURON (BAY CITY – CHEBOYGAN) SOLD OUT**

Trainees will depart from the Appledore's homeport of Bay City, Michigan and voyage north to East Tawas where we will explore the State Park. Next we will sail overnight and arrive at, Pilot Cove on Drummond Island, by sunrise. Here we will explore the shoreline and take part in training activities onboard the ship. The following day we will sail around the island to an anchorage off secluded Whitney Bay. On the final day we will sail across the top of Lake Huron to Cheboygan where we will spend the final night on the ship.

**VOYAGE #2 – NORTHERN LAKE HURON (CHEBOYGAN – CHEBOYGAN) SOLD OUT**

Leaving from Cheboygan, the schooner Appledore will head northeast to Whitney Bay on Drummond Island where we will anchor and row to shore in the ship's tender. Next we will sail around the island to Pilot Cove. Here we will have a cook-out on the beach. Our next stop will be Harbor Island where we will go ashore to explore the island. As we head back toward Cheboygan, we will stop at Les Cheneaux Islands and hike on the shoreline trails. For day five, we will be visiting beautiful Mackinac Island and explore the wild uninhabited parts of the island. Our trip will finish back in Cheboygan.

**VOYAGE #3 – LAKE HURON (CHEBOYGAN – PORT HURON) SOLD OUT**

On this voyage we will sail the entire length of Lake Huron. After departing Cheboygan, our first stop is Mackinac Island where we will explore the wild uninhabited parts of the island. As we leave the Harbor, we will sail east to Drummond Island to explore the shoreline. At our next stop, Presque Isle, we will anchor in a sheltered cove and row the ship's tender to shore. Once on shore we can swim from the sandy beach. On the final day we will dock overnight in Port Huron alongside the schooner Highlander Sea.

**VOYAGE #4 – LAKE HURON TO LAKE ERIE (PORT HURON – SANDUSKY) SOLD OUT**

Sail through the St. Clair and Detroit Rivers on to Sandusky, Ohio in this voyage. On the first day we will set sail straight away in order to reach our first destination in the Detroit River by evening. The following day we will sail southeast to the Bass Islands Archipelago. While here, options include rowing the ship's tender to shore, a cook-out on the beach, swimming from shore or the ship, and exploring the many beautiful islands.

**VOYAGE #5 – LAKE ERIE (SANDUSKY – SANDUSKY)**

Departing from Sandusky, this voyage will take trainees to the Bass Islands Archipelago in western Lake Erie. While here we will explore the many beautiful islands, row and sail the ship's tender, have a cook-out on the beach, swim from shore or the ship, and of course sail the schooner in one of the most interesting areas of the Great Lakes. Likely stops include, Bass Island, Kelley's Island, and Middle Bass Island. On the final day we will sail to Sandusky.

**VOYAGE #6 – LAKE ERIE (SANDUSKY TO LORAIN)**

**VOYAGE #7 – LAKE ERIE (BUFFALO – CLEVELAND)**

On this voyage we will sail 200 miles of Lake Erie. Departing from Buffalo, the first stop on this voyage will be Erie, Pennsylvania. While here we will dock near the historic Brig Niagara. Our next stops will be anchorages near Conneaut and Fairport, Ohio. Options in these locations include rowing the ship's tender to shore, swimming, and exploring the area. On the final day we will sail to Cleveland.

**VOYAGE #8 – LAKE ERIE TO LAKE HURON (CLEVELAND – PORT HURON)**

Sail through the Detroit and St. Clair Rivers on to Port Huron, Michigan in this voyage. On the first day we will sail west to the Bass Islands Archipelago. While here, options include rowing the ship's tender to shore, a cook-out on the beach, swimming from shore or the ship, and exploring the many beautiful islands. Next, we will sail north through the Detroit River to reach our destination by sunset. On the final day we will sail to Port Huron.

**VOYAGE #9 – FRESH WATER ECOLOGY VOYAGE ON LAKE HURON (PORT HURON – CHEBOYGAN)**

**COMPETITIVE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE**

In this special voyage, trainees will study the fresh water ecology of Lake Huron. Trainees will sail to some of the most beautiful ports on Lake Huron where we will collect samples for analysis, visit historical sites, and explore many remote islands. The first stop we will visit "Canada's Prettiest Town," Goderich, Ontario. While here we will have the opportunity to explore the town, swim from a sandy beach, and collect samples. From Goderich, we will have a full day of sailing to our next stop, Tobermory. We will have the rare opportunity to explore the Niagara Escarpment and snorkel over the shipwrecks of Canada's Fathom Five National Marine Park. Next, we will visit several towns on Manitoulin Island. The first of which will be Little Current where we will explore the town and take samples. Next we will visit Gore Bay. While here, we will visit the Fish Hatchery located right on the waterfront. In the small towns of Shesheganing and Kagawong on Manitoulin Island, we will hike the Nimkees Trail and the Bridal Veil Falls Trail. From there, we will head north to Drummond Island where we will row the ship's tender to shore, explore the island, and have a cook-out on the beach. Mackinac Island is always a favorite stop for our trainees and crew alike. On the final day, we will reach Cheboygan, our final destination.
